

April 13

Dunnsden Vineyard, Private residence, Healdsburg

11180 Los Amigos Road, Healdsburg

Take 101 north of Santa Rosa, take the Arata Ln exit just north of Windsor. Turn north onto Los Amigos Rd for 1 mile. Turn right at 11180 onto a shale drive; there will be three address, including 11180. Go to the top of the hill. You will see a sign over entry that says Dunnsden. No tasting room. This is a vineyard, not a winery. We are welcome to go anywhere on the property.

Hills, vistas, and vineyard views, 24 acres. Bathroom available.

April 20

Private Residence, Sebastopol

Private residence north of Sebastopol, 2878 and 2880 Sullivan Road, Sebastopol

Go west on Graton Rd from 116, turn left on Sullivan, turn right at the graveyard (there is a sharp left just after the graveyard and the right is where this curve is). Go up the gravel road and look for the address sign on the right. The residents' names are also on the sign -- Piers and Smith. Park around the entrance and please don't block the driveway. Bathroom available. Apple trees in bloom, HOPEFULLY, Mt St Helena backdrop.

April 27

Kozlowski Farms, Forestville

5566 Gravenstein Hwy (116), Forestville

Located between Graton and Forestville, watch for the signs on the west side of Hwy. Charming farmhouse, apple trees, outbuildings, valley & vineyard views. Don't park in front of the store. 12:30 Critique at picnic tables under trees.

May 4

South Salmon Creek

From Bodega Bay go north on Hwy 1 to South Salmon Creek turnoff.

Park in free parking lot, don't park on the narrow street. Ocean, creek, dunes, summer cottages, restroom. Bring your own shade. Critique in parking lot.

May 11

PAINT OUT & Annual POTLUCK

at the home of Lorraine & Don Levias

780 W School St., Cotati

Directions: coming from north on 101, exit Gravenstein Hwy/CA 116, turn right. Left on W Cotati Ave, slight right onto Maple Ave, slight right onto W School St, PARK on either side of driveway, NOT on street.

Country views include: barns, farm animals, eucalyptus trees, ranch land. Park on either side of driveway, NOT on street. Potluck at 12:30 with critique.

May 18

The Bishop's Ranch

5297 Westside Road, Healdsburg

A gracious retreat - gardens, historic and modern buildings that overlook a vista of rolling hills, vineyards and St. Helena. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: There is limited parking. If upper parking lots are filled, park in the lower parking lot and walk .5 miles up to the center. \$3-5 donation payable at reception is mandatory. Critique by chapel.

May 25

Bartholomew Park Winery

1000 Vineyard Lane, (end of Castle Road), Sonoma

From Santa Rosa, take Hwy 12 to Sonoma, left on Spain St, left of 4th St East, right on Lovall Vly Rd, left on 7th, left on Castle Rd. When entering, take road on left and park at Hiking Trail parking lot. Stunning gardens/trees, lake, vineyard and hill views, shade, formal & informal woods n' paths, gazebo on old Women's Institution grounds. Restroom and tables there where 12:30 critique will be.

June 1

Villa Grande

Take River Road to Monte Rio Theater. Turn left, cross the bridge, then turn right onto Moscow Rd. Go 0.8 miles; turn right onto Russian River Ave and park where you can. Quaint hidden town above the Russian River with summer cottages, redwoods, flowers, river, and pleasant lanes. Critique in front of old store.

June 8

Shollenberger Park, Petaluma

Directions to get to Shollenberger Park:

From Santa Rosa (going south on Hwy 101) or San Rafael (going north on Hwy 101), take the Highway 116 (Lakeville Highway), turnoff in Petaluma and go east for about one mile. Turn right on Cader Lane...at stop sign, going straight takes you right into park. The city park sign is very small and looks like a road identification sign).

Petaluma rolling hills, waters & rushes, birding galore, Petaluma slough & boats deeper in on west side, & 101 Bridge, etc., views. Can also go further east & park at the Pt. Reyes Bird Observatory's back lot, on right just past tall glass building.

June 15

Richards' Grove and Sara Lee's Vineyard

3575 Slusser Rd, Windsor

From Hwy 101 northbound, take River Rd exit, turn left to head west, turn right on Slusser Rd. PARK ON BLACKTOP at classroom or winery above on right. Cultivated gardens, including at entrance with train car restroom, vineyards and hill views, beautiful. Critique at 12:30pm on grassy area near entrance.

June 22th

Matanzas Creek Winery

6097 Bennett Valley Road, Santa Rosa

Peak Lavender season, Bennett Valley hills. Parking below the lavender fields is requested and of course "we always encourage a visit to our Tasting Room!"

June 29

Rosso & Bianco

101 North to Independence Lane, Geyserville

Though under re-model with access more in the back than before and slightly more rustic than before, still vineyard and hill views. Do not park in L shaped area near disabled parking nor tasting room/restaurant entry. Kitchen gardens near tasting room will be nice, and old oak trees.

July 6

Riverfront Regional Park

7821 Eastside Road, Healdsburg (closer to Windsor)

From Santa Rosa, take Hwy 101 North to Central Windsor exit. Turn left onto Old Redwood Hwy. Stay straight and turn left onto Windsor River Rd. Turn left onto Eastside Road for 1.9 miles. Regional Parking fee: \$5. Critique in the Regional Park redwood grove. Shady redwood groves, sunny lake scenes in bird paradise to walk in to (maybe best for early arrivals).

July 13

Marin Cheese Factory

7500 Red Hill Rd, Petaluma

Coming from Santa Rosa South Hwy. 101: Take the E. Washington St. Exit (2nd exit) At the light turn Right on E. Washington St. Follow E. Washington St. to the 3rd stoplight and turn Left on Lakeville Street.;Turn Right at the next light on "D" Street. Follow "D" Street 11 miles until you see the only Firehouse. We are just after the Firehouse on the Right side. Lake, water fowl, surrounding hills, please park at back of lot & do not block walkways.

July 20

Healdsburg Veterans Memorial Beach

13839 Old Redwood Highway, Healdsburg

There is shade and restrooms, views of bridges and river or park and buildings. \$6 parking fee. Critique in the park.

July 27

Howarth Park

650 Summerfield Road, Santa Rosa

From 101 take Hwy 12 exit east, stay straight to stay on Hoen, left on Summerfield, right into park.

Overview Surrounded by oak and eucalyptus trees, lake w/recreational boat, fowl & figure painting opportunities. Critique in shade near boathouse.
